

My speech movie




I like to watch TV. 💆

Mum or Dad will come with me.




I will wait and play with toys or read books until it is my turn.

I will copy them saying the words I have been practicing at home.




The x-ray machine will be making the movie that I might be able to watch afterwards.


The machine is noisy and big but it doesn't touch me or hurt at all.
