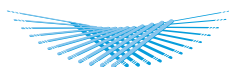




My speech movie

My favourite movie is:

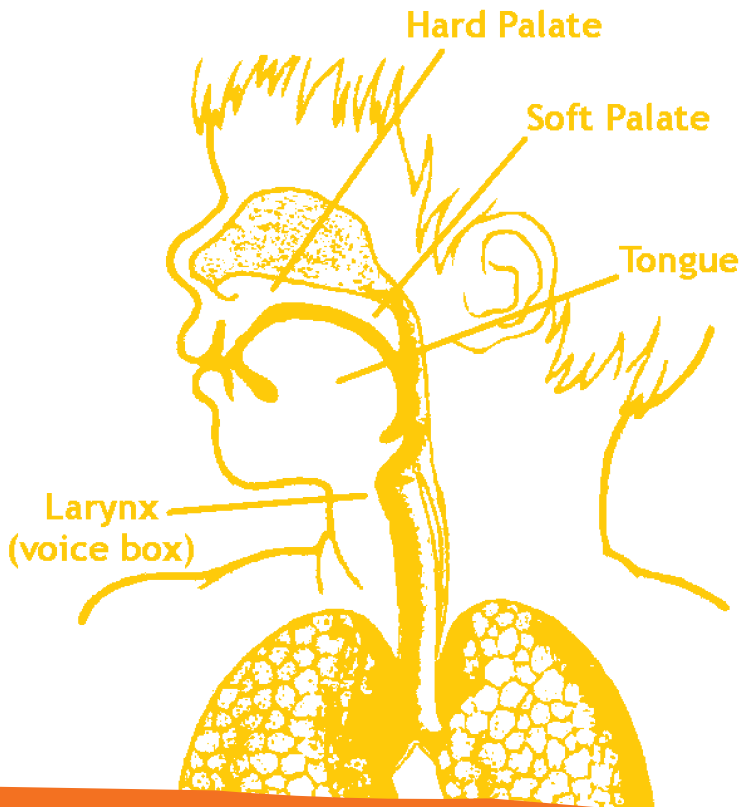


Soon I am off to the hospital to

“Lisa saw a slow horse”

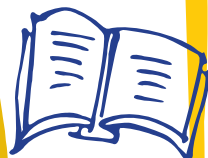
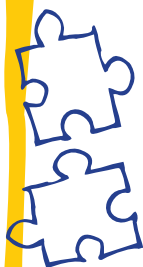
“Ashley will wash a shell”

come with me.



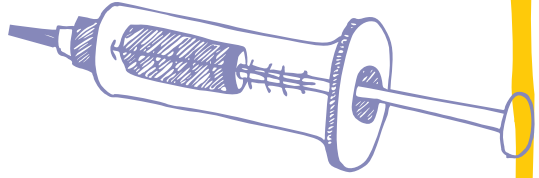
I will wait and play with toys or

into the x-ray room.



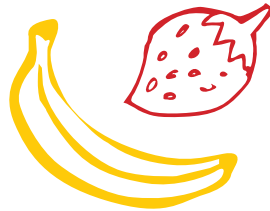
Mum or Dad will come with me.

strawberry or banana flavour?

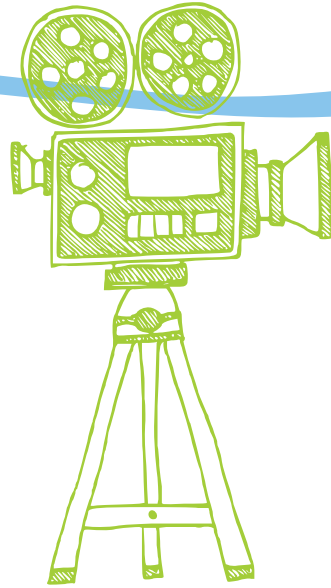


I will sit on a box nice and still

funny and very heavy coat.

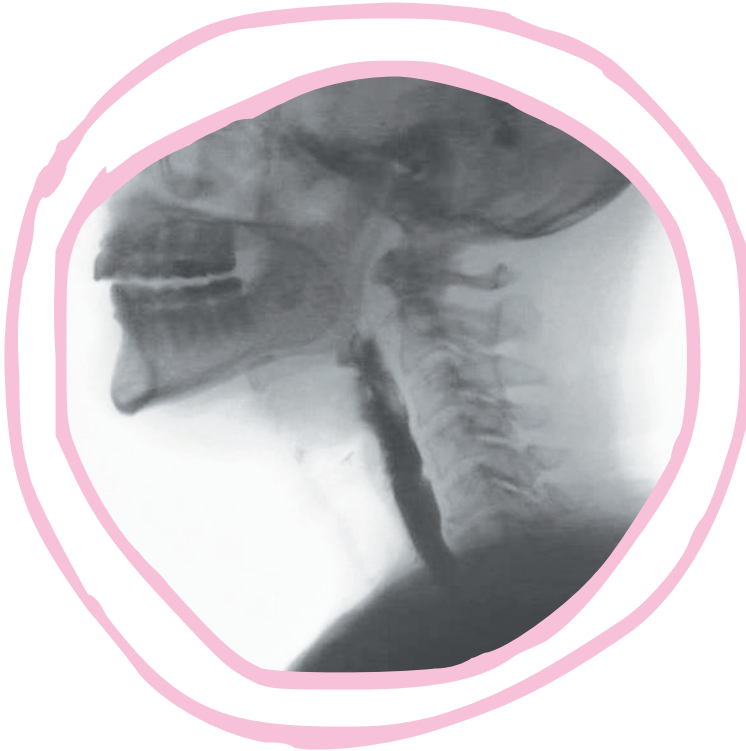
I will copy them saying the words
