# Te Whare Tapa Whā

#### Te Taha Hinengaro - Psychological Health

Focuses on emotions. The mind and body are inseparable. Communication through emotions is important and more meaningful than the exchange of words.

#### Te Taha Wairua - Spiritual Health

Recognised as the essential requirement for health and wellbeing. Without spiritual awareness, an individual may lack wellbeing and be more prone to ill health. Wairua explores relationships with the environment, people and heritage.

#### Te Taha Tinana - Physical Health

Focuses on physical wellbeing and bodily care.
Tinana suffers when a person is under emotional stress, or is unwell. Pain in different parts of your body is tinana communicating what is going on consciously or unconsciously.

#### Te Taha Whānau - Family Health

The most fundamental unit of Māori society. Whānau are clusters of individuals descended from a fairly recent ancestor and may include up to three or four generations. The beliefs, expectations or opinions of the whānau can have a major impact on how we live our lives and the decisions we make

## Oranga o te Tangata Public & Community Health

- **Tamariki Ora/Well Child** Provide milestone checks for children aged between o and 5; provide education and support for mothers and guardians about the care of their babies
- **Project Energize** work in schools promoting healthy eating and activity messages
- **Stop Smoking** a six-week programme that includes one-on-one and/or group support and nicotine replacement therapy to help stop smoking
- Whānau Ora Navigators assist whānau identify steps to enable them to achieve their goals and aspirations; support whānau to become self-directing and empower them to lead their whānau into a positive future
- Whānau Ora Education & Employment Coordinator – support whānau into

- employment or education; help them identify their strengths and skills and motivate them to achieve prerequisites for employment or education; drivers licence programme
- Disability Information & Service –
   (DIAS) Assist those over 50 years with
   impairments to retain their independence
- Kaumātua Support Groups Paeroa, Coromandel, Thames, Whangamatā and Te Aroha
- **Rongoa Mirimiri** traditional Māori healing
- Iwi Health Promotion empower Rangatahi and whānau to be in control of their own ora/wellness
