
RADIATION THERAPY AUCKLAND CITY HOSPITAL

The Radiation Therapy department is located at Auckland City Hospital, Park Road, Grafton, Building 8 (Regional Cancer and Blood Services - see map below) on Level 4. The building is an orange brick building behind the main hospital buildings. The main entrance is opposite Buildings 7 and 9.

Parking is difficult at the hospital. Limited parking is available for patients in the designated 'Oncology' spaces outside Building 8, and just after Building 8 (see map below). Please ensure you get a parking permit from our Reception and allow extra time to find a park. Alternatively, Carparks A and B (37, 33 below) are available at an hourly rate or you can park in the Auckland Domain, this is free but the time limit is monitored by Auckland City Council.





Several buses, including the Inner Link Bus, stop outside building 1 of the hospital. The Grafton train station is 500m from the hospital.
