CADS Auckland Opioid Treatment Service (AOTS) provides support and medications (methadone or suboxone[®]) to people dependent on opioids.

Ongoing individualised treatment or short term reduction plans are available depending on your needs.

Opioid substitution treatment (OST) is well documented as a very effective treatment which offers stability and gives people time to change their lifestyle and begin their recovery.
