District Health Board Fertility Benefit:

Fertility Plus offers staff working at any of the northern region DHB's a 10% discount on treatments, excluding medication charges. This is inclusive of ADHB, CMDHB, WDHB, NDHB and also includes St John Ambulance Staff.

Cost estimate:

A cost estimate for your cycle will be prepared at the time of cycle planning.

Notes about payment:

- Invoices will be sent in the first week of treatment.
- Payment for the cycle is required in full by the day of trigger, insemination, or the day of embryo thaw depending on the treatment cycle you are doing.
- Treatment will not proceed if the payment has not been made.
- Medication is required to be paid at the clinic when picking up the prescription.
- Subsequent cycles including frozen transfers, will not be commenced if there is an outstanding balance.
- Prices are in NZ dollars and include GST.
- Payment methods: Cash, EFTPOS, online banking.
- Prices may be subject to change without notice.
- The chance of pregnancy depends on many factors; there are no refunds if you do not become pregnant.
- Please ensure that your contact information is up to date as your invoices will be emailed or posted to you.

Cancellation policy:

- If your IVF, frozen embryo transfer or IUI cycle gets cancelled you may be eligible for a partial refund (see page 4 & 5 for details).
- Drugs, scans, blood tests and administration fees are not refundable.
- Unused medication cannot be refunded once been issued.
- If your ovulation induced cycle with Letrozole or Clomiphene is unsuccessful there is no refund.

Counselling Appointment, when not included in a treatment package: 60 minutes.	\$140 per 60-minute session

Ovulation Induction and Monitoring

Tracked Cycle - a fully monitored natural cycle using blood tests and ultrasound of the ovaries to detect ovulation.	\$420 per cycle
Letrozole Cycle - a three-month treatment package using Letrozole to stimulate ovulation. Monitoring of your blood test results and feedback will be provided. One review appointment is included if your treatment is not successful.	\$485 per three-month cycle <i>plus medication costs \$25</i>
Letrozole Cycle - a single treatment using Letrozole to stimulate ovulation. Monitoring of your blood test results and feedback will be provided.	\$180 per cycle <i>plus medication costs \$25</i>
Clomiphene - to stimulate the ovaries, tracked with blood tests and possible ultrasound.	\$300 per cycle <i>plus medication costs \$25</i>
Follicle Stimulating Hormone (FSH) – injections, monitored stimulated cycle using blood tests and ultrasound of the ovaries to detect.	\$850 per cycle <i>plus medication costs \$1500 - \$2500</i>

<p><u>Donor Insemination (DI)</u> - with personal donor sperm:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • blood tests • ultrasound 	<p>\$1260 <i>plus medication costs</i> \$25 - \$350</p>

Third Party Treatments

<u>Donor Egg Addition</u> - includes cycle coordination and monitoring, final screening prior to commencing cycle (does not include FER cycle).	\$2100
<u>Donor Egg Work Up</u> - includes two medical consultations (one for recipient and one for donor), up to three counselling sessions, screening blood tests and genetic testing.	\$1785
<u>Donor Egg Reimbursement</u> - charge billed to all recipients, reimbursed to egg donors as petrol vouchers.	\$1500
<u>Donor Sperm Addition in IVF</u>	\$400
<u>Surrogacy Work up</u> - charge work up of potential surrogate – screening tests and co-ordination with Nurses – separate to ECART application which holds all counselling and medical interviews.	\$1050
<u>Surrogacy</u> - FER co-ordination of multiple parties.	\$250
<u>ECART Application</u> - Surrogacy and Embryo Donation, includes all preparation and submission of required documentation to ECART, all appointments with a counsellor and consultant. This does not include the costs for legal preparations. This will be discussed during your initial counselling appointment.	\$2600
